Invitation to Tender for seized and time up goods

Customs and Excise Division Invites Tenders for the purchase of various goods as set out below and marked “Customs Tender November 2021”

**1. Goods to be tendered**

Lots 1 – 90 comprise of 200 litres of hydraulic mechanical gear grease oil, welding rods, tyres (315/80 R22.5 20PR TR668, 315/80R22.5 20PR TR918, 245/70 111S R16, 265/75R16 TR 246), Inner tubes, 50KW GENSET, Electrical and plumbing accessories, Machinery parts, vehicle parts and accessories and five vehicles (2 Toyota Caldina, 1 Toyota Corolla, 1 Nissan Xtrail and 1 Toyota RAV4) which are located at Customs Queens Warehouse 2, Henderson.

Inspection of goods is on Fridays commencing on the 5<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> November 2021 from 9:00 am to 12 noon.

## **2. Conditions of Tender**

The tender will close on November, 30<sup>th</sup> 2021 at 4pm. No late tenders will be accepted.

At the close of the Tender period, Customs Tender Committee will convene to open the tender applications, check for completeness and sort into highest to lowest tender. Tender applicants who did not meet the conditions of tender will not be considered. The Comptroller of Customs has the final decision on the applications.

Winning tenders approved by the Comptroller will be notified. Goods must be paid in full within five (5) working days of notification. If the goods are not paid for, then the next winning bidder will be offered the goods, with the same conditions of settlement.

The time limits for removal of the Tendered items shall be seven (7) working days after payment of the items.
